



3.4.1. Extension activities are carried out in the neighbor hood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and impact thereof during the last five years.

Describe the impact of extension activities in sensitizing students to social issues and holistic development within a maximum of 500 words.

Response:

By solving the problems in the society, the nation is moving towards progress. 26 percent of the youth population of the society is working in higher education today. With 26 percent of the youth in education, it is very important to make them aware of the social issues facing the country and to plan and discuss solutions to solve the issues from the awareness of these issues. As we are looking at the research process, if the research question is clear, then the solution is found and through that solution, the problem can be overcome.

For example, when James Wyatt wondered why the lid of the kettle blew off, like people started running on steam power, if the students start to understand the problems facing the society clearly, the nation can develop from the understanding of those questions. The current issues facing the country like **Gender issue**, **Female Feticide**, **Farmer suicide**, Declining ratio of higher education in Buldhana district, **Cyber security** and **measures**, **poverty** and **unsanitary** etc. problems are seen in the villages and districts, of college area, students are made aware of such issues and to solve such issues every year, various programs are organized by NSS, NCC units. Regarding the gender issue, 1872 Tarabai Shinde, who commented on the gender issue in those days when it was quite difficult and challenging, so Buldhana was came to be known as an active district in the field of feminism.

So the measures given by her on this question become important after one and a half centuries, so a program is organized for the college youth. As the majority of the students studying in the college are from farmers' families, discussions are also held on various problems in agriculture, and solutions are helped through such discussions. The coordinator of Taluka Hospital and District General Hospital Dr. Kambal madam is in constant contact with the students and implements activities in the tehsil with the help of students for public awareness. In Buldhana district, it is very demanding in the National Education Ratio. To increase the ratio in higher education, college professors go to villages and conduct

awareness programs for the 12th passed students and also try to increase the ratio of academic higher education through parent contact. In order to increase the birth rate of girls, Buldhana district is lagging behind in the birth rate of Girls. The College has also been actively involved in (Save girl) Aamchi Moolgi campaign. In short, for the development of the society, the work of awakening and awareness of is done by the college.

Extension activities NSS in 2018-19

1.Tree Plantation Program (Dated 09 July 2018):

At village Palaskhed Sapkal adopted by National Service Scheme, the students planted 50 trees in the villages of Palaskhed Sapkal with their cooperation. This tree included Indian plants like neem, pimpal, mango, tamarind, jambhul etc.

Special emphasis was given on this as it was a cleanliness drive. In these programs, Vice Principal Anil Purohit Prof. Satish More Prof. Ulhas Brahm and program officers participated.



3. Voter Awareness Rally and Program (September 4, 2018 and March 26, 2019):

To educate the public about voting through National Service Scheme and register new youth as voters. For this, a voter awareness rally was organized on September 4. Along with this, students guided that every citizen should exercise their right to vote in order to increase the voting percentage by going to the houses of the locality as a justification for the Lok Sabha elections.

Extension activities NSS in 2019 - 20

1. Relief Rally for Flood Victims (August 22, 2019):

In August 2019, due to heavy rains, flood conditions were created across Maharashtra in the state of emergency in which all the belongings of the poor people were washed away due to water inundation. 8250 rupees were collected for the flood victims by holding a round of aid and this aid was sent through the tehsil office. MLAs from the city, President Secretary and student teachers participated in helping the flood victims.



2. Blood Donation Camp (March 7, 2020):

In the wake of Corona, the stock of blood of various blood types was extremely reduced, making blood available to the needy. Responding to the challenge of Hon'ble Prime Minister and Hon'ble Chief Minister, a special blood donation camp was organized by the college. Many students donated blood in this.



Extension activities NSS in 2020-21

1.Tree Planting Program (August 15, September 1 & 5, 2020):

Extension activities NSS in 2021-22

1. Mission Kavach Kundal (October 25, 2021 to January 28, 2022):

Corona vaccination was organized by the Maharashtra government in order to get out of the epidemic of global compassion and prevent this disease from happening. The National Service Scheme and the college participated in this initiative of the government. For this vaccination, the rural hospital Chikhli and the students of the college brought the senior citizens of the surrounding area to the college to vaccinate them. In this program, 210 students got themselves vaccinated while 125 citizens took advantage of this vaccination in the college. It was also challenged to remove the misunderstandings related to vaccination by telling journalists and direct information so that citizens come forward for vaccination.
